

## How to Attach a 4” Sleeve to Your Quilt

1. Cut a piece of fabric 8 1/2” wide X the width of your quilt.
2. Turn under the short ends of the quilt and stitch.

If your quilt is NOT bound yet, follow to Step 3. If your quilt is already bound, skip to Step 4.

3. (Quilt NOT bound) Fold the fabric in half, wrong sides together, the long way and press. Place the long raw edges even with the raw edges of the backside of the quilt. Baste in place. Once the binding is applied, the sleeve will be stitched in place along the top. Slip stitch the bottom folded edge to the quilt, being sure to sew through to the batting for added strength.
4. (Quilt Bound) Fold the fabric in half, wrong sides together, and stitch 1/4” from the raw edge to create a tube. Place the tube so that the seam runs down the middle, and press open. Place the sleeve on the back of the quilt so that the open pressed is against the back of the quilt, just below the binding. Slip stitch both the top and the bottom of the tube to the quilt, being sure to sew through to the batting for added strength.
